 - Ensuring that the information being used for analysis and decision making is reliable

INDICATOR MODEL

• The LCG team design and implemented the online indicators alongside the SAP databases which allowed us to observe the processes in real time. Furthermore, all the formats and reports were developed in accordance to the operative requirements of the company.
